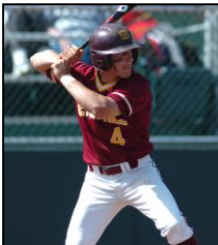
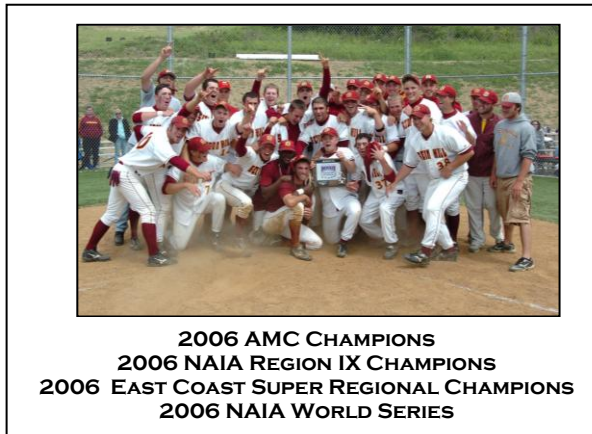

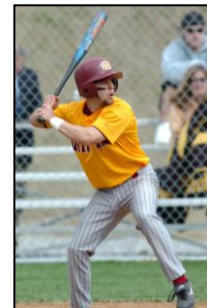

MARC MARIZZALDI - Head Coach

Coach Marizzaldi led SHU to its first NAIA World Series appearance and #14 national ranking in just his third season, accumulating a 179-130 overall record in six years at Seton Hill, after serving a year and a half as the top assistant coach at his alma mater, Duquesne University. Marizzaldi, the 2006 AMC and NAIA Region IX Coach of the Year, coordinated all winter and summer camps at Duquesne, including the school's first ever USA Baseball Camp and Showcase in 2002. Prior to his stint at Duquesne, Marizzaldi served two seasons as the pitching coach at nationally ranked Division III Lakeland College in Wisconsin, as well as one season as manager of the Sheboygan A's of the Wisconsin State League. After completing his pitching career at Duquesne, Marizzaldi coached at Baldwin High School for three seasons and managed the Baldwin American Legion to a 52-20 record during the summers of 1999 and 2000.

BRANDON WHITFIELD - Asst. Coach

After completing one of the most successful individual careers in SHU Baseball history, Brandon Whitfield returns for his second year as hitting/infield coach for the Griffins in 2010. Whitfield left the diamond with a .375 career average, complimented by 112 career RBI and a long-standing record of 21 career triples. Whitfield stands as the Griffins only All-American after being a 2nd Team selection in 2006. He earned 1st Team AMC honors at second base twice in 2005 and 2006, and his 56 stolen bases and 137 runs rank him second in each category on the Griffins all-time charts. Whitfield's 90 hits and 220 at-bats during the 2006 season reign atop the SHU single-season record books.

STEVE LONG - Asst. Coach

After a decorated playing career for the Griffins from 2004-2007, Long enters his second season as pitching coach for the Griffins in 2010. As SHU's only true two-way player, Long registered 16 victories on the mound during his career, striking out 136 batters against just 46 walks in 208 innings. Long finished with a career average of .314 with 35 doubles and 97 career runs batted in. He was twice named All-Conference; once as a 2nd Team AMC outfielder in 2004 and then as a 1st Team AMC pitcher in 2006. Long assisted the Griffins in the fall of 2007 in a volunteer capacity as he finished his undergraduate degree in education, then joined the coaching staff at Hampton HS for the 2008 spring season.

All Sessions will run from **9:30am – 11:30am** and be held in Sullivan Gymnasium. The facility has two indoor batting cages, two pitching machines, and soft-toss & tee areas.

Each session will include in-depth instruction on swing mechanics and philosophies of hitting used at the collegiate and Major League levels. Campers will work through specific hitting drills and live hitting, as well as receive video analysis of their swings.

It is recommended that players wear tennis shoes, bring their own bats, helmets if available, and most important, batting gloves.....
