Page 37:

Second column, first paragraph, should be changed to read "Courses that satisfy this requirement are identified...by the letters TH. *3 credits are required.*"

Pages 53, 54, 55:

Replace required courses BL150, BL151, BL152, and BL153 with BL160, BL161, BL162, and BL163.

Pages 73 and 74:

Replace required courses BL150 and BL151 with BL160 and BL161.

Page 94:

BL150 General Biology I – remove first sentence of description.

BL152 General Biology II, BL153 General Biology II Laboratory - no longer offered.

New courses:

BL160 Organismal Biology

Study of the evolution of prokaryotes and eukaryotes and the diversity of plants and invertebrate animals. *Corequisite: BL161. Fall semester. 3 credits.*

BL161 Organismal Biology Laboratory

Laboratory study of the diversity of plants and invertebrate animals. *Corequisite: BL160. Fall semester. 1 credit. Fee.*

BL162 Plant Biology and Ecology

Study of form and function of vascular plants and basic ecological concepts. *Corequisite: BL163. Spring*

semester. 3 credits.

BL163 Plant Biology and Ecology Laboratory

Laboratory study of anatomy and physiology of vascular plants and basic ecological concepts.

Corequisite: BL162. Spring semester. 1 credit. Fee.

Page 214:

New course: **ED555 Online Teaching and Learning**

This course provides an overview of the many facets of teaching and learning within a virtual environment. Course activities are designed to provide practical experience utilizing a web-based course management system, effective instructional strategies, and a variety of emerging technologies within a virtual classroom environment. *Repeatable for credit. Permission of instructor is required. Offered spring, summer, and fall. Pass/Fall only. Variable credit.*

Remove ED605 as prerequisite under ED530 and ED835.

Page 217:

New course: **EL255 The Bible as Literature**

This is an introductory literature course in reading the Bible. The course surveys the formation of the Bible related to Judaic and Christian traditions. Students will examine diverse literary forms: from mythic stories of origin and prophecies to poems and parables. Students will develop the skill of critically reading biblical literature through a theological lens. *Spring semester, even-numbered years. Satisfies the Theology requirement of the Liberal Arts Curriculum. 3 credits.*
